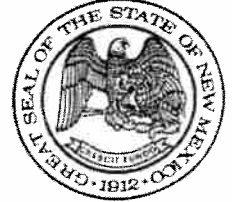

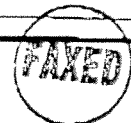

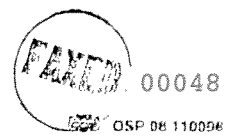

November 19, 2010

Follow-up from Notice of Violation issued November 9, 2010

Item 1

- a. Correction not completed. New ventilation system is planned and is currently out for bid.
- b. Plant cleanliness is acceptable, however, tile grout still show stains from mold and mildew. Want to see more attention given to cleaning tile grout. Note: this problem should be resolved with adequate ventilation.

Item 2

- a. Lids for open sumps are being constructed. Sealed lids over sumps will be accepted in lieu of moving sumps 100 feet from plant only if odors from sumps are contained.
- b. Stagnant whey in front of whey silo has been eliminated and area slopes to drain.
- c. Much of the area by receiving and behind the plant has been cleaned.
- d. Direct access from courtyard to offices and processing area has not been eliminated.

Items 3, 4 and 5 remain unchanged

Items 6 and 7 have been corrected

Item 8

- a. Shelves have not been raised for easy cleaning underneath.
- b. Provide doors to processing room that better control entry of flies and insects.

Item 9

- a. Soap and paper towels at available basins have been provided.
- b. Additional handwash facility at packaging area has not been provided.

Additional observations made during inspections conducted November 16 and 17

1. Found several lots of raw milk cheese that had been cut and packaged into consumer size packaging prior to required minimum 60 days aging. Strongly recommend not cutting raw milk cheese prior to 60 days aging.
2. Container truck used to store packaging material used in plant had numerous other articles stored in close proximity that were unrelated to plant manufacturing. Also, door to storage contained was not closed and appears open most of the time.

3. Plant soaps and sanitizer labels not legible. Miscellaneous articles stored too close to chemicals.
4. Cutting and packaging of cheese is conducted in an area exposed to excessive foot traffic from employees accessing raw milk processing area of plant.
5. Proximity of raw milk cheese vat to area where cheese is cut and wrapped is very close.
6. Employees working in cutting/packaging area must walk to cheese processing area of plant to obtain sanitizer to sanitize equipment in their work area. Also, it did not appear hands or equipment were subjected to sanitizer for sufficient time for proper properly
7. Upstairs storage room is very cluttered and does not appear to be used for storage of items needed for cheese plant but instead are retail store items, causing unnecessary foot traffic. Storage areas used for cheese plant are overcrowded. Suggest cleaning and reorganizing of warehouse areas.

FDA, CDC, and Costco warn consumers to avoid Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese

Cheese may be related to outbreak of E.coli infections

Fast Facts

- Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese, (Costco item 40654) offered for sale and in cheese sampling events at Costco Wholesale Corporation (Costco) locations is preliminarily linked with an outbreak of *E.coli* O157:H7 infections.
- Consumers who have any of this cheese should not eat it. They should return the cheese to the place of purchase or dispose of it in a closed plastic bag and place in a sealed trash can to prevent people or animals, including wild animals, from eating it.
- Most people infected with *E. coli* O157:H7 develop diarrhea and abdominal cramps, but some illnesses may last longer and can be more severe. While most people recover within a week, some may develop a severe infection. Rarely, as symptoms of diarrhea improve, a type of kidney failure called hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS) can occur; this can happen at any age but is most common in children under 5 years old and in older adults. People with HUS should be hospitalized immediately, as their kidneys may stop working and they may be at risk for other serious health problems.
- As of Thursday, November 4, 2010, 25 persons infected with the outbreak strain of *E. coli* O157:H7 have been reported from five states since mid-October. The number of ill persons identified in each state with this strain is as follows: AZ (11), CA (1), CO (8), NM (3) and NV (2). There have been 9 reported hospitalizations, 1 possible case of hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS), and no deaths.

What is the Problem?

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention join Costco Wholesale Corporation (Costco), in warning consumers not to consume Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese (Costco item 40654), as this cheese may be associated with an outbreak of *E.coli* O157:H7 infections. The cheese was available for sale, and free samples were offered for in-store tasting at Costco in Arizona, California, Colorado, New Mexico and Nevada.

What are the Symptoms of Illness/Injury?

Most people infected with *E. coli* O157:H7 develop diarrhea and abdominal cramps, but some illnesses may last longer and can be more severe. While most people recover within a week, some may develop a severe infection. Rarely, as symptoms of diarrhea improve, a type of kidney failure called hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS) can occur; this can happen at any age but is most common in children under 5 years old and in older adults. People with HUS should be hospitalized immediately, as their kidneys may stop working and they may be at risk for other serious health problems.

What Do Consumers Need To Do?

Do not eat Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese (Costco Item 40654) purchased at Costco. Consumers should return this product to the place of purchase or dispose of it in a closed plastic bag and place in a sealed trash can to prevent people or animals, including wild animals, from eating them. Anyone who experienced signs or symptoms of *E. coli* O157:H7 infection should contact his or her healthcare provider immediately. Healthcare providers should report any suspected infection to state or local public health authorities right away.

Where is it Distributed?

Costco offered the Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese for sale and for in-store tasting at its stores in Arizona, California, Colorado, New Mexico and Nevada.

What is Being Done to Protect Consumers?

The FDA, CDC and Costco are working together on the investigation and will update the public with more information as soon as it is available. As more information becomes available, the recommendations to consumers may change. The FDA, in conjunction with the state of California, has initiated an investigation at Bravo Farms.

In addition, Costco is advising consumers to return any remaining Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese they may have at home to Costco for a full refund. Costco has voluntarily removed the cheese from its stores and, using card purchase records, has notified consumers by phone of the situation.

Investigation Update: Multistate Outbreak of *E. coli* O157:H7 Infections Associated with Cheese

Updated November 24, 2010

Today's Highlights

- Bravo Farms has expanded its recall to include all of its cheeses. This action follows laboratory testing by the California Department of Food and Agriculture that reveals the presence of *Listeria monocytogenes* and *E. coli* O157:H7 in cheese samples.
- Thirty-eight persons infected with the outbreak strain of *E. coli* O157:H7 have been reported from five states since mid-October. The number of ill persons identified in each state with this strain is as follows: AZ (19), CA (3), CO (11), NM (3) and NV (2). There have been 15 reported hospitalizations, 1 case of hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS), and no deaths. To date, no illnesses associated with *L. monocytogenes* in Bravo Farm cheese have been reported.

Investigation of the Outbreak

CDC is collaborating with public health officials in Arizona, California, Colorado, New Mexico, Nevada, the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' Food and Drug Administration (FDA), and the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Food Safety and Inspection Service (FSIS) to investigate a multistate outbreak of human infections due to *E. coli* O157:H7. This is a rare strain of *E. coli* O157:H7 that has never been seen before in the [PulseNet \(www.cdc.gov/pulsenet/\)](http://www.cdc.gov/pulsenet/) database. PulseNet is the national subtyping network made up of state and local public health laboratories and federal food regulatory laboratories that performs molecular surveillance of foodborne infections.

Thirty-eight persons infected with the outbreak strain of *E. coli* O157:H7 have been reported from five states. The number of ill persons identified in each state with this strain is as follows: AZ (19), CA (3), CO (11), NM (3) and NV (2). Dates of illness onset range from October 16, 2010 through October 27, 2010. Patients range in age from 1 to 85 years and the median age is 16 years. There have been 15 reported hospitalizations, 1 case of hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS), and no deaths.

The outbreak can be visually described with a chart showing the number of persons who became ill each day. This chart is called an **epidemic curve or epi curve** (www.cdc.gov/ecoli/2010/cheese0157/epi.html). Illnesses that occurred after November 4, 2010 might not yet be reported due to the time it takes between when a person becomes ill and when the illness is reported. This takes an average of 2 to 3 weeks.

Current Status of the Investigation

Laboratory testing conducted by the New Mexico Department of Health on an *unopened* (intact) package of Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda Cheese purchased from a Costco retail location has identified *E. coli* O157:H7 matching the outbreak strain. This is the first confirmation from an unopened cheese sample, and is consistent with previous laboratory testing conducted on two *opened* packages of the Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda Cheese purchased at Costco, which also identified *E. coli* O157:H7 matching the outbreak strain. These *opened* packages were from two different case patients' homes. Testing on two additional *opened* packages from other case patients' homes is in process.

FDA is continuing to work with its state partners to investigate Bravo Farms and to identify potential sources of contamination. FDA has collected product samples for testing.

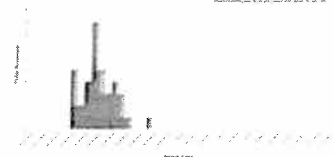
Additional investigative activities are ongoing and include:

- Conducting surveillance for additional illnesses that could be related to the outbreak.
- Gathering and testing food products that are suspected as possible sources of infection to see if they are contaminated with bacteria.
- Following epidemiologic leads gathered from interviews with patients, food purchase information, or from patterns of processing, production and/or distribution of suspected products.
- Investigating where in the distribution chain the point of contamination could have occurred.

Costco is cooperating and assisting with this ongoing investigation.

Recall Information

On November 23, 2010, Bravo Farms expanded its recall to include all of its cheeses. This action follows laboratory testing by the California Department of Food and Agriculture that reveals the presence of *Listeria monocytogenes* and *E. coli* O157:H7 in cheese samples. Bravo Farms sell a variety of cheeses at retail stores throughout the US, mainly on the West coast, including Gouda, Pepper Jack, Tulare Cannonball, and several different styles and flavors of Cheddar cheese. To date, no illnesses associated with *L. monocytogenes* in Bravo Farm cheese have been reported. Clinical Features/Signs and Symptoms

Most people infected with *E. coli* O157:H7 develop diarrhea (often bloody) and abdominal cramps 2-8 days (3-4 days, on average) after swallowing the organism, but some illnesses last longer and are more severe. Infection is usually diagnosed by stool sample culture. While most people recover within a week, some develop a severe infection. A type of kidney failure called hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS) can begin as the diarrhea is improving; this can occur among persons of any age but is most common in children under 5 years old and the elderly. Signs and symptoms of HUS may include: fever, abdominal pain, pale skin tone, fatigue and irritability, small, unexplained bruises or bleeding from the nose and mouth, decreased urination and swelling of the face, hands, feet, or entire body. Persons who experience these symptoms and believe they are at risk for HUS should seek emergency medical care immediately.

Advice to Consumers

Consumers who have any Bravo Farms Cheeses should not eat them. Instead, they should return the cheeses to the place of purchase or dispose them in a closed plastic bag placed in a sealed trash can. This will prevent people or animals, including wild animals, from eating it.

CDC's Role in Food Safety

CDC leads federal efforts to gather data on foodborne illnesses, investigate foodborne illnesses and outbreaks, and monitor the effectiveness of prevention and control efforts. CDC is not a food safety regulatory agency but works closely with the food safety regulatory agencies, in particular, with FDA and FSIS. CDC also plays a key role in building state and local health department epidemiology, laboratory, and environmental health capacity to support foodborne disease surveillance and outbreak response. Notably, CDC data can be used to help document the effectiveness of regulatory interventions.

The California Department of Food and Agriculture (CDFA) is forwarding this release from Bravo Farms regarding an expanded recall of the company's cheeses:

Bravo Farms Cheese Recall

Bravo Farms is expanding its recall to include all Bravo Farms cheese. Bravo Farms had previously issued a recall on its Dutch Style Gouda, and now out of concern for any further contamination we have decided to further expand the recall to include all of our cheeses. Our customer's safety and well being are our top priority, and this is the best way we can be sure we fulfill this obligation.

Bravo Farms sells a variety of cheeses at retail stores throughout the US, mainly on the west coast, including Gouda, Pepper Jack, Tulare Cannonball, and several different styles and flavors of Cheddar cheese.

Through cooperation with the FDA and CDFA we have begun thorough testing of the plant due to the E. Coli contamination that was found in the Gouda. *Listeria monocytogenes* and E.Coli O157:H7 bacteria were detected by CDFA during the investigation. To date, no illnesses associated with *Listeria* in Bravo Farm cheese have been reported. Consumers should discard the cheese or return it to the place of purchase. Our customers know we have high standards and that we produce some of the best tasting cheeses in the United States. We recently were awarded Top Cheddar in the United States in August.

E. coli O157:H7 causes diarrhea illness often with bloody stools. Although most healthy adults can recover completely within a week, some people can develop a form of kidney failure. Young children and the elderly are most susceptible to serious complications and even death. *Listeria* can cause listeriosis among at risk people, including pregnant women, newborns, older adults, and people with weakened immune systems. Symptoms include fever, muscle aches, and sometimes nausea or diarrhea. If infection spreads to the nervous system, symptoms such as headache and stiff neck can occur. Infected pregnant women may experience only a mild, flu like illness; however, infections during pregnancy can lead to more serious problems for the fetus. Consumers should seek immediate medical care if they develop these symptoms.

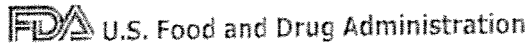

The action follows laboratory testing by the California Department of Food and Agriculture that revealed the presence of *Listeria monocytogenes* and *E. coli* O157:H7 in cheeses. UPDATE: Nov. 16, 2010: *Laboratory testing conducted by the New Mexico Department of Health on an unopened (intact) package of Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda Cheese purchased from a Costco retail location has identified *E. coli* O157:H7 matching the outbreak strain. This is the first confirmation from an unopened cheese sample, and is consistent with previous laboratory testing conducted on two opened packages of the Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda Cheese purchased at Costco, which also identified *E. coli* O157:H7 matching the outbreak strain. These opened packages were from two different case patients' homes. Testing on two additional opened packages from other case patients' homes is in process.*

UPDATE: Nov. 10, 2010: *Laboratory testing conducted on two opened packages of Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda Cheese purchased at Costco from two different case patient's homes has identified *E. coli* O157:H7 matching the outbreak strain. Preliminary laboratory testing conducted on an unopened package of Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda Cheese obtained from a Costco retail location has identified *E. coli* O157:H7. Additional laboratory testing is currently ongoing. Preliminary laboratory testing conducted on two additional opened packages of Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda Cheese purchased at Costco from two other case patient's homes has indicated the presence of *E. coli* O157:H7. Additional laboratory testing is currently ongoing to confirm these results.*

FDA is working with its state partners to investigate Bravo Farms and to identify potential sources of contamination. FDA has collected product sample for testing.

*On Nov. 5, 2010, Bravo Farms voluntarily recalled all Dutch Style Gouda cheese because it may be contaminated with *E. coli* O157:H7. It was also distributed through various retail stores within California in 8 oz. pieces. The lot codes are numbers less than 0233.*

- Consumers who have any of this cheese should not eat it. They should return the cheese to the place of purchase or dispose of it in a closed plastic bag and place in a sealed trash can to prevent people or animals, including wild animals, from eating it.
- Most people infected with *E. coli* O157:H7 develop diarrhea and abdominal cramps, but some illnesses may last longer and can be more severe. While most people recover within a week, some may develop a severe infection. Rarely, as symptoms of diarrhea improve, a type of kidney failure called hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS) can occur; this can happen at any age but is most common in children under 5 years old and in older adults. People with HUS should be hospitalized immediately, as their kidneys may stop working and they may be at risk for other serious health problems.

What is the Problem?

The U.S. Food and Drug Administration and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention join Costco Wholesale Corporation (Costco), in warning consumers not to consume Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese (Costco item 40654), as this cheese may be associated with an outbreak of *E. coli* O157:H7 infections. The cheese was available for sale, and free samples were offered for in-store tasting at Costco in Arizona, California, Colorado, New Mexico and Nevada.

What are the Symptoms of Illness/Injury?

Most people infected with *E. coli* O157:H7 develop diarrhea and abdominal cramps, but some illnesses may last longer and can be more severe. While most people recover within a week, some may develop a severe infection. Rarely, as symptoms of diarrhea improve, a type of kidney failure called hemolytic uremic syndrome (HUS) can occur; this can happen at any age but is most common in children under 5 years old and in older adults. People with HUS should be hospitalized immediately, as their kidneys may stop working and they may be at risk for other serious health problems.

What Do Consumers Need To Do?

Do not eat Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese (Costco Item 40654) purchased at Costco. Consumers should return this product to the place of purchase or dispose of it in a closed plastic bag and place in a sealed trash can to prevent people or animals, including wild animals, from eating them. Anyone who experienced signs or symptoms of *E. coli* O157:H7 infection should contact his or her healthcare provider immediately. Healthcare providers should report any suspected infection to state or local public health authorities right away.

Where is it Distributed?

Costco offered the Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese for sale and for in-store tasting at its stores in Arizona, California, Colorado, New Mexico and Nevada.

What is Being Done to Protect Consumers?

The FDA, CDC and Costco are working together on the investigation and will update the public with more information as soon as it is available. As more information becomes available, the recommendations to consumers may change. The FDA, in conjunction with the state of California, has initiated an investigation at Bravo Farms.

In addition, Costco is advising consumers to return any remaining Bravo Farms Dutch Style Gouda cheese they may have at home to Costco for a full refund. Costco has voluntarily removed the cheese from its stores and, using card purchase records, has notified consumers by phone of the situation.

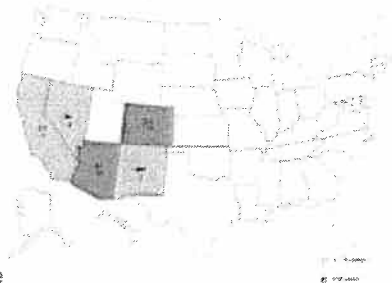
